

## Application Guide for Theology Driven Ministry Curriculum

### TDM in Sunday School

#### Lesson 11 –General Revelation

**Scripture Focus:** Psalm 19:1-6

**Memory Verse:** Ps. 19:1 “The heavens are telling of the glory of God; and their expanse is declaring the work of His hands” NKJV

**Key Biblical Truth:** As a person develops eyes that see and ears that hear the revelation of God in nature and in Scripture, their reasonable response is to humbly submit to God.

#### Study Questions:

**Monday:** How does the universe declare the glory of God? What can you learn about God from the stars and from space?

**Tuesday:** According to verse 2, when is nature not showing God’s glory?

**Wednesday:** Who is the audience of the declaration of God’s glory in verses 3-4? What does this mean in terms of who can be held accountable for being confronted by God’s revelation?

**Thursday:** Verses 4b-6 give an example of how the sun glorifies God. How does this happen? What is the truth revealed here about how all of creation reveals the glory of God?

**Friday:** What part of creation is not included in all that, “declare the glory of God?”

#### Application Questions:

1. What can we learn by understanding that all nature declares the glory of God? What should seeing a sunrise, or spending time watching the waves roll in at the beach trigger in the mind of all people?
2. Why is humanity not included as part of the creation that will declare His glory in the same way that the sun and the stars will?

**Application Challenge:** Spend time with your family or close friends this week appreciating the natural world around you. As you do this, examine the ways that nature declares the glory of God. Reflect on this thought; what should you be doing to declare the glory of God to those around you.
