

## Application Guide for Theology Driven Ministry Curriculum

### TDM in Sunday School

#### Lesson 9 –Life’s Greatest Question pt. 2

**Scripture Focus:** John 3:1-18

**Memory Verse:** John 3:16-17 “For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life. For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him.”  
NKJV

**Key Biblical Truth:** The gospel is the foundation of redemption.

#### Study Questions:

**Monday:** What Key truth about Jesus do you learn in verse 13?

**Tuesday:** What is the importance of Jesus referring to Moses and the serpent in the wilderness (Num. 21:9)? Why would it be important for Nicodemus to realize that this was Moses’ last miracle before the children of Israel entered the Promised Land?

**Wednesday:** What did it mean for the children of Israel to believe that God would provide healing from the bites of the serpents through looking at the brazen serpent in the rod? How would that relate to what Jesus tells Nicodemus must happen for someone to have eternal life in verse 15?

**Thursday:** What do you learn about the character and nature of God from verse 16?

**Friday:** According to verse 16, who is the atonement of Jesus on the cross for?

#### Application Questions:

1. Have you ever truly trusted God to save your soul as those who were bitten in the wilderness trusted God to save their lives? If so, share a brief testimony to your small group about this time. If not, listen to others and how God changed their lives.
2. If God gave His Son for the sins of the whole world, what does that mean about your deepest, darkest sins? Can they be forgiven? Have you ever confessed your Sin to Jesus and asked for His forgiveness?

**Application Challenge:** This week share with your spouse or close friends about how God has changed your life through redemption.
